What exactly will my Extensivist do?

- Communicate with your primary care physician (PCP) about your hospital stay and care
- Manage your care in the hospital, from admission to discharge
- Monitor care in the time leading up to (such as for pre-surgery visits), during and after hospital stays
- Follow up once the patient is stabilized
- Make rounds at Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs)
- Stay available on-call 24 hours a day, seven days a week should any need arise.

Hospital stays can be very stressful. Our Extensivists ensure you are not getting unneeded tests or procedures that may prolong your hospital stay.

Extensivists are there to oversee the work of any medical specialists in a patient's journey, ensuring that nothing falls through the cracks, and that any treatment recommendations take into account the whole patient, their history, and what will bring them the highest quality of life. They will then communicate all of the information back to your PCP.
